Want more flexibility?

Dear students and/or parents, Jeremy Hutson is pleased to announce a revision of the make up policy. To better accommodate everyone, the 24 hours notice for make up lessons, which is a standard policy for most private instructors, music stores, and other music instruction facilities, has now been eliminated. **No more 24 hour notice!** You will now only be required to give notice prior to the start of the scheduled lesson that will be missed, but please call as soon as possible. If no notice is given, regardless of the reason, that will be considered a no show and the student will not be eligible for a make up. All students may still be eligible to receive one make up lesson per quarter. Also, the studio is now open 5 days a week, and extra make up days are being added to the schedule when possible. That information will be posted in the studio and will appear on your monthly invoice when applicable.
